- 1.3 Prices quoted should be inclusive of all taxes and delivery costs, must be expressed in Kenya shillings and shall remain valid for a period of **120days** from the closing date of the tender.
- 1.4 Interested eligible candidates may obtain further information from and inspect the tender documents at the Supply Chain management Office, situated at the County Headquarters-THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF KISUMU P.O. Box 2738 40100, KISUMU, during normal working hours.
- 1.5 The tender is strictly being accompanied by tender security as stated in the tender documents and as required by the Authority.

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SECTIONII - INSTRUCTIONS TO TENDERERS

2.1 Eligible Tenderers

- 2.1.1 This Invitation to tender is open to all Tenderers eligible as described in the instructions to Tenderers. Successful Tenderers shall provide the services for the stipulated duration from the date of commencement (hereinafter referred to as the term) specified in the tender documents.
- 2.1.2 THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF KISUMU employees, committee members, board members and their relative (spouse and children) are not eligible to participate in the tender unless where specially allowed under section 131 of the Act.
- 2.1.3 Tenderers shall provide the qualification information statement that the Tenderer (including all members of joint venture and subcontractors) is not associated, or have been associated in the past, directly or indirectly, with a firm or any of its affiliates which have been engaged by the COUNTY GOVERNMENT OF KISUMU (CGK) to provide consulting services for the preparation of the design, specifications, and other documents to be used for the procurement of the services under this Invitation for tenders.
- 2.1.4 Tenderers involved in corrupt or fraudulent practices or debarred from participating in public procurement shall not be eligible.

2.2 Cost of Tendering

- 2.2.1 The Tenderer shall bear all costs associated with the preparation and submission of its tender, and the (CGK), willing no case be responsible or liable for those costs, regardless of the conduct or outcome of the tendering process.
- 2.2.2 The price to be charged for the tender document shall not exceed **Kshs.1**, **000/=**.
- 2.2.3 The (CGK) shall allow the Tenderer to review the tender document free of charge before purchase.

2.3 Contents of Tender Document

- 2.3.1 The tender document comprises of the documents listed below and addenda issued in accordance with clause 60f these Instructions to Tenderers
 - (i) Instructions to Tenderers
 - (ii) General Conditions of Contract
 - (iii) Special Conditions of Contract
 - (iv) Schedule of Requirements
 - (v) Details of Service
 - (vi) Form of Tender
 - (vii) Price Schedules
 - (viii) Contract Form
 - (ix) Confidential Business Questionnaire Form
 - (x) Tender Security Form
 - (xi) Performance Security Form
 - (xii) Principal's or Manufacturers Authorization Form
 - (xiii) Declaration Form
- 2.3.2 The Tenderer is expected to examine all instructions, forms, terms, and specifications in the tender documents. Failure to furnish all information required by the tender documents or to submit a tender not substantially responsive to the tender documents in every respect will be at the Tenderers risk and may result in the rejection of its tender.

2.4 Clarification of Documents

- 2.4.1 A prospective candidate making inquiries of the tender document may notify the (CGK) in writing or by post, fax or email at the entity's address indicated in the Invitation for tenders. The (CGK) will respond in writing to any request for clarification of the tender documents, which it receives no later than seven (7) days prior to the deadline for the submission of tenders, prescribed by the (CGK). Written copies of the Procuring entities response (including an explanation of the query but without identifying the source of inquiry) will be sent to all prospective Tenderers who have received the tender documents".
- 2.4.2 The (CGK) shall reply to any clarifications sought by the Tenderer within 3 days of receiving the request to enable the Tenderer to make timely submission of its tender.

2.5 Amendment of Documents

- 2.5.1 At any time prior to the deadline for submission of tenders, the (CGK), for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by a prospective Tenderer, may modify the tender documents by issuing an addendum.
- 2.5.2 All prospective Tenderers who have obtained the tender documents will be notified of the amendment by post, fax or

 Email and such amendment will be binding on them.
- 2.5.3 In order to allow prospective Tenderers reasonable time in which to take the amendment into account in preparing their tenders, the (CGK), at its discretion, may extend the deadline for the submission of tenders.

2.6 Language of Tender

2.6.1 The tender prepared by the Tenderer, as well as all correspondence and documents relating to the tender exchanged by the Tenderer and the (CGK), shall be written in English language. Any printed literature furnished by the Tenderer may be written in another language provided they are accompanied by an accurate English translation of the relevant passages in which case, for purposes of interpretation of the tender, the English translation shall govern.

2.7 Documents Comprising of Tender

- 2.7.1 The tender prepared by the Tenderers shall comprise the following components:
 - (a) A Tender Form and a Price Schedule completed in accordance with paragraph 9, 10 and 11 below.
 - (b) Documentary evidence established in accordance with Clause 2.11 that the Tenderer is eligible to tender and is qualified to perform the contract if its tender is accepted;
 - (c) Tender security furnished is in accordance with Clause 2.12
 - (d) Confidential business questionnaire

2.8 Form of Tender

2.8.1 The Tenderers shall complete the Form of Tender and the Appropriate Price Schedule furnished in the tender documents, indicating the services to be performed.

2.9 Tender Prices

- 2.9.1 The Tenderer shall indicate on the Price schedule the unit Prices where applicable and total tender prices of the services it proposes to provide under the contract.
 - 2.9.2 Prices indicated on the Price Schedule shall be the cost of the services quoted including all customs duties and VAT and other taxes payable:
 - 2.9.3 Prices quoted by the Tenderer shall be fixed during the Tenderer's performance of the contract and not subject to variation on any account. A tender submitted with an adjustable price quotation will be treated as non-responsive and will be rejected, pursuant to paragraph2.22.
- 2.9.4 Contract price variations shall **not** be allowed for contracts not Exceeding one year (12months)
 - 2.9.5 Where contract price variation is allowed, the variation shall not exceed 10% of the original contract price.
 - 2.9.6 Price variation requests shall be processed by the (CGK) within 30 days of receiving the request.

2.10 Tender Currencies

2.10.1 Prices shall be quoted in Kenya Shillings unless otherwise specified in the Appendix to Instructions to Tenderers.

2.11 Tenderers Eligibility and Qualifications

- 2.11.1 Pursuant to paragraph 2.1theTenderer shall furnish, as part of its tender, documents establishing the Tenderers eligibility to tender and its qualifications to perform the contract if its tender is accepted.
- 2.11.2 The documentary evidence of the Tenderers qualifications to perform the contract if its tender is accepted shall establish to the (CGK)'s satisfaction that the Tenderer has the financial and technical capability necessary to perform the contract.

2.12 Tender Security

2.12.1 The Tenderer shall furnish, as part of its tender, a tender Security for the amount and form specified in the Invitation to tender.

2.12.2 The tender security shall be in the amount not exceeding 2per cent of the tender price.

- 2.12.3 The tender security is required to protect the (CGK) against the risk of Tenderer's conduct, which would warrant the security's forfeiture, pursuant to paragraph2.12.7.
- 2.12.4 The tender security shall be denominated in a Kenya Shillings or in another freely convertible currency and shall be in the form of:
 - a) A bank Guarantee.
 - b) Cash.
 - c) Such Insurance Guarantee Approved by the Authority.
 - d) Letter of Credit.
- 2.12.5 Any tender not secured in accordance with paragraph2.12.1 and2.12.3will be rejected by the (CGK) as nonresponsive, pursuant to paragraph2.20.
- 2.12.6 Unsuccessful Tenderer's security will be discharged or returned as promptly as soon as possible but not later than thirty (30) days after the expiration of the period of tender validity prescribed by the (CGK).
 - 2.12.7 The successful Tenderer's tender security will be discharged upon the Tenderer signing the contract, pursuant to paragraph
 - 2.29, and furnishing the performance security, pursuant to paragraph 2.30.
 - 2.12.8 The tender security may be forfeited:
 - (a) If a Tenderer **withdraws** its tender **during** the period of tender validity specified by the (CGK) on the Tender Form; or
 - (b) In the case of a successful Tenderer, if the Tenderer fails:
 - (i) to sign the contract in accordance with paragraph 30

or

- (ii) to furnish performance security in accordance with paragraph31.
- (c) If the Tenderer rejects, correction of an error in the tender.

2.13 Validity of Tenders

- 2.13.1 Tenders shall remain valid for 120 days or as specified in the Invitation to tender after date of tender opening prescribed by the (CGK), pursuant to paragraph 2.18. A tender valid for a shorter period shall be rejected by the (CGK) as non-
- 2.13.2 responsiveIn exceptional circumstances, the (CGK) may solicit. the Tenderer's consent to an extension of the period of validity. The request and the responses thereto shall be made in writing. The tender security provided under paragraph2.12 shall also be suitably extended. A Tenderer may refuse the request without forfeiting its tender security. A Tenderer granting the request will not be required nor permitted to modify its tender.

2.14 Format and Signing of Tender

- 2.14.1 The Tenderer shall prepare two copies of the tender, clearly Marking each "ORIGINAL TENDER" and "COPYOF TENDER," as appropriate. In the event of any discrepancy between them, the original shall govern.
- 2.14.2 The original and all copies of the tender shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by the Tenderer or a person or persons duly authorized to bind the Tenderer to the contract. All pages of the tender, except for un amended printed literature, shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the tender.
- 2.14.3 The tender shall have no interlineations, erasures, or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by the Tenderer, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the person or persons signing the tender.

2.15 Sealing and Marking of Tenders

- 2.15.1 The Tenderer shall seal the original and each copy of the tender in separate envelopes, duly marking the envelopes as "ORIGINAL" and "COPY." The envelopes shall then be sealed in an outer envelope. The inner and outer envelopes shall:
 - (a) be addressed to the (CGK) at the address given in the invitation to tender

- (b) bear, tender number and name in the invitation to tender and the words: "DO NOT OPEN BEFORE 19th November, 2019 at 2:00 pm.
- 2.15.2 The inner envelopes shall also indicate the name and address of the Tenderer to enable the tender to be returned un opened in case it is declared "late".
- 2.15.3 If the outer envelope is not sealed and marked as required by paragraph 2.15.2, the (CGK) will assume no responsibility for the tender's misplacement or premature opening.

2.16 Deadline for Submission of Tenders

- 2.16.1 Tenders must be received by the (CGK) at the address specified under paragraph 2.15.2 no later than "DO NOT OPEN BEFORE 19th November, 2019 at 2:00 pm.
- 2.16.2 The (CGK) may, at its discretion, extend this deadline for the submission of tenders by amending the tender documents in accordance with paragraph 6, in which case all rights and obligations of the (CGK) and candidates previously subject to the deadline will thereafter be subject to the deadline as extended.

 2.16.3 Bulky tenders which will not fit in the tender box shall be received by the (CGK) as provided for in the appendix.

2.17 Modification and Withdrawal of Tenders

- 2.17.1 The Tenderer may modify or withdraw its tender after the tender's submission, provided that written notice of the modification, including substitution or withdrawal of the tender's is received by the (CGK) prior to the deadline prescribed for the submission of tenders.
- 2.17.2 The Tenderer's modification or withdrawal notice shall be prepared, sealed, marked, and dispatched in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 2.15. A withdrawal notice may also be sent by cable, but followed by a signed confirmation copy, postmarked no later than the deadline for submission of tenders.
- 2.17.3 No tender may be modified after the deadline for submission of tenders.
- 2.17.4 No tender may be withdrawn in the interval between the deadline for submission of tenders and the expiration of the period

of tender validity specified by the Tenderer on the Tender Form. Withdrawal of a tender during this interval may

result in the Tenderer's forfeiture of its tender security, pursuant to paragraph2.12.7.

- 2.17.5 The (CGK) may at any time terminate procurement proceedings before contract award and shall not be liable to any person for the termination.
- 2.17.6 The (CGK) shall give prompt notice of the termination to the Tenderers and on request give its reasons for termination within 14 days of receiving the request from any Tenderer.

2.18 Opening of Tenders

- 2.18.1 The (CGK) will open all tenders in the presence of Tenderers' Representatives who choose to attend, at **DO NOT OPEN BEFORE 19th November, 2019 at 2:00pm** and in the location specified in the invitation to tender. The Tenderers' representatives who are present shall sign a register evidencing their attendance.
- 2.18.3 The Tenderers' names, tender modifications or withdrawals, tender prices, discounts, and the presence or absence of requisite tender security and such other details as the (CGK) at its discretion, may consider appropriate, will be announced at the opening.
- 2.18.4 The (CGK) will prepare minutes of the tender opening which will be submitted to the Tenderers that signed the tender opening register and will have made the request.

2.19 Clarification of Tenders

2.19.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of Tenders the (CGK) may at its discretion, ask the Tenderer for a clarification of its tender. The request for clarification and the response shall be in writing, and no change in the prices or substance shall be sought, offered, or permitted.

2.19.2 Any effort by the Tenderer to influence the (CGK) in the (CGK)'s tender evaluation, tender comparison or contract award decisions may result in the rejection of the Tenderers tender.

2.20 Preliminary Examination and Responsiveness

2.20.1 The (CGK) will examine the tenders to determine whether they are complete, whether any computational errors have been

made, whether required securities have been furnished whether the documents have been properly signed, and whether the tenders are generally in order.

2.20.2 Arithmetical errors will be rectified on the following basis. If there is a discrepancy between the unit price and the total price that is obtained by multiplying the unit price and Quantity, the unit price shall prevail, and the total price shall be corrected. If the candidate does not accept the correction of the errors, its tender will be rejected, and its tender security may be forfeited. If there is a discrepancy between words and figures, the amount in words will prevail.

- 2.20.3 The (CGK) may waive any minor informality or nonconformity or irregularity in a tender which does not constitute a material deviation, provided such waiver does not prejudice or affect the relative ranking of any Tenderer.
- 2.20.4 Prior to the detailed evaluation, pursuant to paragraph 23, the (CGK) will determine the substantial responsiveness of each tender to the tender documents. For purposes of these paragraphs, a substantially responsive tender is one which conforms to all the terms and conditions of the tender documents without material deviations. The (CGK)'s determination of a tender's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the tender itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence.
- 2.20.5 If a tender is not substantially responsive, it will be rejected by the (CGK) and may not subsequently be made responsive by the Tenderer by correction of the nonconformity.

2.21 Conversion to a Single Currency

2.21.1 Where other currencies are used, (CGK) will convert those Currencies to Kenya shillings using the selling exchange rate on the date of tender closing provided by the central bank of Kenya.

2.22 Evaluation and Comparison of Tenders.

2.22.1 The (CGK) will evaluate and compare the tenders which have been determined to be substantially responsive, pursuant to paragraph2.20

2.22.2 The comparison shall be of the price including all costs as well as duties and taxes payable on all the materials to be used in the provision of the services.

- 2.22.3 The (CGK)'s evaluation of a tender will take into account, in addition to the tender price, the following factors, in the manner and to the extent indicated in paragraph 2.22.4 and in the technical specifications:
 - (a) operational plan proposed in the tender;
 - (b) Deviations in payment schedule from that specified in the Special Conditions of Contract.
 - 2.22.4 Pursuant to paragraph 22.3 the following evaluation methods will be applied:

(a) Operational Plan

The (CGK) requires that the services under the Invitation for Tenders shall be performed at the time specified in the Schedule of Requirements. Tenders offering to perform longer than the (CGK)'s required delivery time will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.

(b) Deviation in Payment Schedule

Tenderers shall state their tender price for the payment on a schedule outlined in the special conditions of contract. Tenders will be evaluated on the basis of this base price. Tenderers are, however, permitted to state an alternative payment schedule and indicate the reduction in tender price they wish to offer for such alternative payment schedule. The (CGK) may consider the alternative payment schedule offered by the selected Tenderer.

2.22.5 The tender evaluation committee shall evaluate the tender within 30 days from the date of opening the tender.

- 2.22.6 To qualify for contract awards, the Tenderer shall have the following: -
 - (a) Necessary qualifications, capability experience, services, equipment and facilities to provide what is being procured.
 - (b) Legal capacity to enter into a contract for procurement
 - (c) Shall not be insolvent, in receivership, bankrupt tor
 in the process of being wound up subject of legal proceedings relating to the foregoing
 - (d) Shall not be debarred from participating in public procurement.

2.23 Contacting the (CGK)

- 2.23.1 Subject to paragraph 2.19, no Tenderer shall contact the (CGK) on any matter relating to its tender, from the time of the tender opening to the time the contract is awarded.
- 2.23.1 Any effort by a Tenderer to influence the (CGK) in its decisions on tender evaluation tender comparison or contract award may result in the rejection of the Tenderers tender.

2.24 Award of Contract

(a) Post Qualification

- 2.24.1 In the absence of pre-qualification, the (CGK) will determine to its satisfaction whether the Tenderer that is selected as having submitted the lowest evaluated responsive tender is qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily.
- 2.24.2 The determination will take into account the Tenderer's financial and technical capabilities. It will be based upon an examination of the documentary evidence of the Tenderers qualifications submitted by the Tenderer, pursuant to paragraph 2.1.2, as well as such other information as the (CGK) deems necessary and appropriate.
- 2.24.3 An affirmative determination will be a prerequisite for award of the contract to the Tenderer. A negative determination will result in rejection of the Tenderer's

tender, in which event the (CGK) will proceed to the next lowest evaluated tender to make a similar determination of that Tenderer's capabilities to perform satisfactorily.

(b) Award Criteria

- 2.24.4 Subject to paragraph 2.29 the (CGK) will award the contract to the successful Tenderer whose tender has been determined to be substantially responsive and has been determined to be the lowest evaluated tender, provided further that the Tenderer is determined to be qualified to perform the contract satisfactorily.
- 2.24.5 The (CGK) reserves the right to accept or reject any tender and to annul the tendering process and reject all tenders at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Tenderer or Tenderers or any obligation to inform the affected Tenderer or Tenderers of the grounds for the (CGK)' sanction. If the (CGK) determines that none of the Tenderers is responsive; the (CGK) shall notify each Tenderer who submitted a tender.
- 2.24.6 A Tenderer who gives false information in the tender document about its qualification or who refuses to enter into a contract after notification of contract award shall be considered for debarment from participating in future public procurement

2.25 Notification of Award

2.25.1 Prior to the expiration of the period of tender validity, the (CGK) will notify the successful Tenderer in writing that its tender has been accepted.

- 2.25.2 The notification of award will signify the formation of the Contract subject to the signing of the contract between the Tenderer and the (CGK) pursuant to clause2.29. Simultaneously the other Tenderers shall be notified that their tenders have not been successful.
- 2.25.3 Upon the successful Tenderer's furnishing of the performance security pursuant to paragraph 31, the (CGK) will promptly notify each unsuccessful Tenderer and will discharge its tender security, pursuant to paragraph2.12.

2.26 Signing of Contract

2.26.1 At the same time as the (CGK) notifies the successful Tenderer that its tender has

been accepted, the (CGK) will simultaneously inform the other Tenderers that their tenders

have not been successful.

- 2.26.2 Within fourteen (14) days of receipt of the Contract Form, the successful Tenderer shall sign and date the contract and return it to the (CGK).
- 2.26.3 The parties to the contract shall have it signed within 30days from the date of notification of contract award unless there is an administrative review request.

2.27 Performance Security

- 2.27.1 Within thirty (30) days of the receipt of notification of award from the (CGK), the successful Tenderer shall furnish the performance security in accordance with the Conditions of Contract, in the Performance Security Form provided in the tender documents, or in another form acceptable to the (CGK).
- 2.27.2 Failure of the successful Tenderer to comply with the requirement of paragraph 2.29 or paragraph 2.30.1shall constitute sufficient grounds for the annulment of the award and forfeiture of the tender security, in which event the (CGK) may make the award to the next lowest evaluated or call for new tenders.

2.28 Corrupt or Fraudulent Practices

- 2.28.1 The (CGK) requires that Tenderers observe the highest standard of ethics during the procurement process and execution of contracts. A Tenderer shall sign a declaration that he has not and will not be involved in corruptor fraudulent practices.
- 2.28.2 The (CGK) will reject a proposal for award if it determines that the Tenderer recommended for award has engaged incorrupt or fraudulent practices in competing for the contraction question;
- 2.28.3 Further, a Tenderer who is found to have indulged incorrupt or fraudulent practices risks being debarred from participating in public procurement in Kenya.

Appendix to Instructions to Tenderers

The following information for procurement of services shall complement or amend the provisions of the instructions to Tenderers. Wherever there is a conflict between the provisions of the instructions to Tenderers and the provisions of the appendix, the provisions of the appendix here in shall prevail over those of the instructions to Tenderers.
