1 **Roposed Design For Rehabilitation & Up-Grade Of Jamhuri Park–Kisumu**

1.1 **Proposed interventions**

Kisumu City is set to host Africities Summit in the year 2021. The premiere conference is expected to bring with it tens of thousands of delegates and should set Kisumu and the region on a tourism growth trajectory. Jamhuri park, being strategically placed right next to the County headquarters in the heart of the leafy suburbs of Milimani estate offers an appropriate point for relaxation, reflection and interaction for the delegates and the residents of Kisumu. It is best given an academic theme with a resource central steep.

The preparation of the conference therefore offers the City of Kisumu an opportunity to review the state of this park and rehabilitate it, not only for the purposes of the Africities Summit, but more so, to serve its role as a recreational facility.

It is therefore proposed that the following interventions be undertaken on Jamhuri Park:

- i. Design, rehabilitation and upgrading of the recreational and other facilities in the park, include:
 - a. Concrete Perimeter fence with alternating green hedges
 - b. The green vegetation, including laying of new grass carpet, repair/replacement of flower beds and pruning of trees;
 - c. The perimeter fence with solar powered lighting, set-up pedestrian gates and security booths installation.
 - d. Establishment and equipping of a resource center
 - e. Improved public cloakroom facilities;
 - f. Establish well designed footpaths.
 - g. Installation of park benches and literbins;
- ii. Establishment of a public-private partnership deed for the park to offer a democratic, participatory and inclusive management structure and systems for sustainable upkeep of the recreational facility, through:
- iii. Establishing a policy to ensure that the recreational facilities are accessible to all members of the public, including the poor, for use for recreational purposes, educational purposes, entertainment, sports, exhibitions, and appropriate business activities.

2 Proposed Design For Rehabilitation & Up-Grade Of Oile Park-Kisumu

2.1 Proposed interventions

Kisumu City is set to host Africities Summit in the year 2021. The premiere conference is expected to bring with it tens of thousands of delegates and should set Kisumu and the region on a tourism growth trajectory. Oile park, being strategically placed at the intersection of two major highways – Nairobi Road and Kakamega Road, can offer an appropriate point of relaxation and interaction for the delegates and the residents of Kisumu

The preparation of the conference therefore offers the City of Kisumu an opportunity to review the state of this park and rehabilitate it, not only for the purposes of the Africities Summit, but more so, to serve its role as a recreational facility

It is therefore proposed that the following interventions be undertaken on Oile Park:

- i. Design, rehabilitation and upgrading of the recreational and other facilities in the park, include:
 - a. Concrete Perimeter fence with alternating green hedges
 - b. The green vegetation, including laying of new grass carpet, repair/replacement of flower beds and pruning of trees;
 - c. The perimeter fence with solar powered lighting, set-up pedestrian gates and security booths installation
 - d. Improved toilet facilities;
 - e. Establish well designed footpaths
 - f. Installation of park benches and litterbins; and
- ii. Establishment of a public-private partnership deed for the park to offer a democratic, participatory and inclusive management structure and systems for sustainable upkeep of the recreational facility, through:
 - iii. Establishing a policy to ensure that the recreational facilities are accessible to all members of the public, including the poor, for use for recreational purposes, educational purposes, entertainment, sports, exhibitions, and appropriate business activities.

3 Proposed Design For Establishment of Prof. Nyongó Botanical Garden- Kisumu

3.1 Background

Prof. Nyongó Botanical Garden is the former dumpsite which for many years has been an eyesore in the lakeside City. The relocation of this dumpsite being one of the major milestones in the achievements of the current governor, the park was named after him. He on the other hand honored the victims of the 2017 post-election violence by dedicating a corner named after “Baby Pendo”.

3.2 Proposed interventions

Kisumu City is set to host Africities Summit in the year 2021. The premiere conference is expected to bring with it tens of thousands of delegates and should set Kisumu and the region on a tourism growth trajectory.

The preparation of the conference therefore offers the City of Kisumu an opportunity to review the state of this park and rehabilitate it, not only for the purposes of the Africities Summit, but more so, to serve its role as a recreational facility.

It is therefore proposed that the following interventions be undertaken on Prof. Nyongó Botanical Garden:

- i. Design, rehabilitation and upgrading of the recreational and other facilities in the park, include:
 - a. Concrete Perimeter fence with alternating green hedges
 - b. The green vegetation, including laying of new grass carpet, repair/replacement of flower beds.
 - c. Planting of indigenous tree species;
 - d. The perimeter fence with solar powered lighting, set-up pedestrian gates and security booths installation.
 - e. Establishment of an alternative sports recreation facility like a swimming pool.
 - f. Establish modern public cloakroom facilities;
 - g. Establish well designed footpaths.
 - h. Establishment of a monument in honor of fallen heroes during the 2017 post-election violence at “Baby Pendo” Corner.
 - i. Installation of park benches and litterbins;
 - ii. Establishment of a public-private partnership deed for the park to offer a democratic, participatory and inclusive management structure and systems for sustainable upkeep of the recreational facility, through:

iii. Establishing a policy to ensure that the recreational facilities are accessible to all members of the public, including the poor, for use for recreational purposes, educational purposes, entertainment, sports, exhibitions, and appropriate business activities.

4 Proposed Beautification & Greening Of The City- Kisumu

4.1 Proposed interventions

Kisumu City is set to host Africities Summit in the year 2021. The premiere conference is expected to bring with it tens of thousands of delegates and should set Kisumu and the region on a tourism growth trajectory. The major trunks/highways to the City, estate roads and the roundabouts form part of the major attraction points as the visitors enters the City. The preparation of the conference therefore offers the City of Kisumu an opportunity to review the state of these major trunks/highways to the City, estate roads and the roundabouts and rehabilitates them, not only for the purposes of the Africities Summit, but more so, to serve its role as a recreational facility.

It is therefore proposed that the following interventions be undertaken:

- I. Tree planting
- II. Landscaping
- III. Grassing
- IV. Installation of planter boxes for flower planting

The following roads have been proposed for beautification and greening;

- a. Kisumu – Busia road = 4.9 kilometers (2 roundabouts)
- b. Jomo Kenyatta highway = 2.0 kilometers (2 roundabouts)
- c. Kisumu boys roundabout – kiboswa road = 10.8 kilometers (8 roundabouts)
- d. Nairobi road (Kisumu boys roundabout – Buoye) = 9 kilometers (2 roundabouts)
- V. Kisumu City roads
